

## Privacy Policy

Trivoly.com takes your privacy very seriously. We will never sell your personally identifiable information to a third party without your explicit consent. Effective Date: November 01, 2015

Welcome to our web site, Trivoly.com (the "Site"), owned by Trivoly.com. ("Trivoly" or "we" or "us" or "our"). This Privacy Policy describes our collection, use and disclosure of information on the Site.

### What we collect

We collect personally identifiable information such as name, company affiliation, title, e-mail address, and other contact information through the Site if you choose to provide it to us, such as by submitting a form on the Site or sending us an e-mail.

We also automatically collect information regarding your interaction with our Site, such as how long you visit the Site and which pages you visit. Visits to the Site are logged in our servers, which record the time, IP address, device operating system, browser information and other technical information, referrer (current, previous, or parent browser page) and the server request.

### How we collect data

Information, including personally identifiable information, may be collected through forms you fill out and submit to us on the Site. In addition, other non-personally identifiable information may be collected automatically by our servers when you browse the Site as described above.

We may use cookies and web beacons to maintain your Site preferences and to be able to log unique visitors to our Site. "Cookies" are small text files containing a string of alphanumeric characters that are downloaded by your web browser when you visit a web site, while beacons are clear 1x1 pixel images. The use of cookies and beacons is very common. We may use both session cookies and persistent cookies. A session cookie disappears after you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains after you close your browser and may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to the Site. Persistent cookies can be removed.

Like many websites, Trivoly.com.com does not currently respond to "do not track" browser headers. But you can take steps to limit tracking by erasing cookies from your computer's hard drive and by setting your browser to block all cookies or warn you before a cookie is stored. Please review your web browser's documentation to learn the best way to modify your cookie settings. Cookies may also be used for advertising purposes, as further described below under the "Advertising" heading below.

### What we do with this data

We use the information we collect in any manner reasonably related to the purpose it was provided to us, such as to process and communicate with you regarding your product order, respond to a request for information about our products or to contact a job applicant.

We may also use information we collect in order to operate, maintain, enhance, and provide all of the features and services found on the Site, develop new products and services, measure the effectiveness of any promotions found on the Site and to monitor Site usage metrics such as total number of visitors and pages accessed.

We may use collected information to e-mail you promotional information regarding our products and services or have our representatives or affiliates to contact you regarding purchase of Trivoly products. Any such e-mails will contain instructions on how to opt-out of receiving such e-mails in the future.

### How we share data

Personally identifiable information you provide to us through the Site is not shared with third parties, except that all information, including personally identifiable information: (i) may be provided to our representatives, affiliates or service providers who may use the information on our behalf for purposes described in this privacy policy; and (ii) may be stored on servers and facilities provided to us by third party vendors. As one example of a disclosure we may make to a representative, if you submit a request to us to be contacted regarding more information about our products and services, we may pass that request to a third party sales partner for handling.

In addition, any and all information, including personally identifiable information, may be transferred as part of any merger, acquisition, debt financing, sale of company assets, or similar transaction, as well as in the event of insolvency, bankruptcy, or receivership in which information could be transferred to third parties as one of our business assets.

We also reserve the right to disclose information (including personally identifiable information) when we believe, in good faith, that the disclosure is appropriate or necessary: to take precautions against liability; to protect us from fraudulent, abusive, or unlawful activities; to investigate and defend ourselves against third-party claims or allegations; to assist government enforcement agencies; to comply with legal process, such as a subpoena; to protect the security or integrity of the Site; or to protect the rights, property, or personal safety of any person or entity.



## Credit Card Information

We do not receive your credit card number or billing information when you make a purchase on the Site. Credit card and billing information is collected and used directly by our payment services provider, Adyen. ## Advertising

We may partner with third party companies that allow us to deliver online advertisements to users who visit our site. This is a common practice called "retargeting."
